World premiere on October 13, 2022, at the Korundi Culture Centre in Rovaniemi, performed by the Lapland Chamber Orchestra in collaboration with ballet students from the Lapland Music and Dance Institute.

World premiere on February 19, 2026, at Kirkenes Church (Kirkenes kirke) in Kirkenes, Norway, performed by the Lapland Chamber Orchestra.
